COMES NOW PETITIONER, SCOTT C. SUZUKI, ESQ., Probate Special Counsel in Kalima v. Hawaii, Civil No. 99-4771-12 LWC filed in the Circuit Court of the First Circuit, State of Hawaii (hereinafter "*Kalima*")<sup>1</sup>, and hereby petitions this Court pursuant to H.R.S. §554D-201 and Hawaii Probate Rules 28, 29 and 126, for instructions as follows:

1. Petitioner's name is SCOTT C. SUZUKI, ESQ., in his capacity as Probate Special Counsel in *Kalima*.

2. The KALIMA CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT TRUST DATED JUNE 23, 2023 (hereinafter the "Trust") was established by the Circuit Court of the First Circuit, State of Hawaii, pursuant to the FIRST AMENDED JOINT ORDER APPROVING PROBATE PLAN AND QUALIFIED SETTLEMENT TRUST filed in *Kalima* on or about June 23, 2023 (hereinafter the "Joint Order Approving Probate Plan").

3. This Honorable Court has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to H.R.S. §554D-202.

4. Venue before this Honorable Court is appropriate pursuant to H.R.S. § 554D-204(a), as the principal place of administration is in this Judicial Circuit.

5. A true and correct copy of the Trust is available online at [kalima-lawsuit.com](http://kalima-lawsuit.com).<sup>2</sup>

Petitioner was able to speak with the deceased class member's daughter, **EUNICE L. PATE**. It is Petitioner's understanding that the deceased class member raised **EUNICE L. PATE**, but **BRENDA BISHAW-SAKUMOTO** was raised by deceased class member's parents. Petitioner further understands that the deceased class member had designated **EUNICE L. PATE** as beneficiary of her estate, including lease succession.

**EUNICE L. PATE** informed Petitioner that **BRENDA BISHAW-SAKUMOTO** and her husband, **RONALD SAKUMOTO**, lived with **EUNICE L. PATE** for many years. **EUNICE L. PATE** cared for **BRENDA BISHAW-SAKUMOTO** during her final illness. Petitioner understands that **RONALD SAKUMOTO** was predeceased by his parents, had no descendants, and was likely pre-deceased by his sibling(s). Petitioner has not been able to locate any family relations for **RONALD SAKUMOTO**. **EUNICE L. PATE** was the contact that **RONALD SAKUMOTO** designated at his final illness and she coordinated his funeral and burial arrangements.

On the basis of the foregoing, Petitioner believes that the intent of the deceased class member would be to devise her estate to **EUNICE L. PATE**. Because the deceased class member died over 20 years ago, it is likely not possible to locate the beneficiary or successorship documentation. Should such documentation be available, however, H.R.S. § 560:2-503 may control to show that the documents are clear and convincing evidence of the deceased class member's intent. Similarly, given the relationship **EUNICE L. PATE** shared with **BRENDA BISHAW-SAKUMOTO** and **RONALD SAKUMOTO**, any

documents showing the relationship could be used to illustrate their intent to leave their respective estates to **EUNICE L. PATE**. If this conclusion is not satisfactory to this Honorable Court, then one-half of the deceased class-member's settlement proceeds would be distributed to **EUNICE L. PATE** and the other one-half would escheat to the State pursuant to H.R.S. § 560:2-105. Petitioner believes that this result would offend the principles of equity which supplement Hawaii's Probate Code pursuant to H.R.S. § 560:1-103, as the State was the defendant obligated to pay the settlement proceeds in the *Kalima* lawsuit.

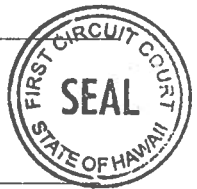
