COMES NOW PETITIONER, SCOTT C. SUZUKI, ESQ., Probate
Special Counsel in Kalima v. Hawaii, Civil No. 99-4771-12 LWC filed
in the Circuit Court of the First Circuit, State of Hawaii
(hereinafter "*Kalima*")¹, and hereby petitions this Court pursuant
to H.R.S. §554D-201 and Hawaii Probate Rules 28, 29 and 126, for
instructions as follows:

1. Petitioner's name is SCOTT C. SUZUKI, ESQ., in his capacity as Probate Special Counsel in *Kalima*.

2. The KALIMA CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT TRUST DATED JUNE 23, 2023 (hereinafter the "Trust") was established by the Circuit Court of the First Circuit, State of Hawaii, pursuant to the FIRST AMENDED JOINT ORDER APPROVING PROBATE PLAN AND QUALIFIED SETTLEMENT TRUST filed in *Kalima* on or about June 23, 2023 (hereinafter the "Joint Order Approving Probate Plan").

3. This Honorable Court has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to H.R.S. §554D-202.

4. Venue before this Honorable Court is appropriate pursuant to H.R.S. § 554D-204(a), as the principal place of administration is in this Judicial Circuit.

5. A true and correct copy of the Trust is available online at kalima-lawsuit.com.²

On the basis of the foregoing, and considering the estimated value of the deceased class member's settlement share, Petitioner believes that the deceased class member's share of the *Kalima* settlement proceeds should be distributed to the deceased class member's surviving spouse, **EMILIE RICH**. Because said surviving spouse is now deceased, her estate would ordinarily control the further distribution of the settlement proceeds. Petitioner has not been able to locate or identify any heirs for **EMILIE RICH**. This may result in the funds escheating to the State of Hawaii. Because the State of Hawaii is the defendant in *Kalima*,

Petitioner believes that it would be more equitable to distribute the settlement proceeds to the descendants of the deceased class member, as they are the step-children of the surviving spouse. This is consistent with the current trend reflected in the Uniform Probate Code, which Hawaii has now adopted.³

Considering the estimated value of the settlement proceeds, Petitioner believes that the deceased class member's share of the *Kalima* settlement proceeds would have been distributed to the surviving spouse, **LEONA MUNDON-KAHOONEI**. 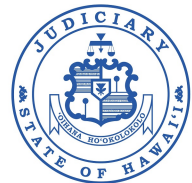
