**SECOND SUPPLEMENT TO PROBATE SPECIAL  
MASTER'S REPORT RE: PETITION FOR INSTRUCTIONS #26**

COMES NOW, EMILY H. KAWASHIMA, ESQ. ("Master"), duly appointed Probate  
Special Master to examine the Petition for Instructions #26, filed January 9, 2026 (the  
"Petition"), and respectfully submits this Second Supplement to the Report.

(C) **LUANA PI'ILANI CHOW**

Your Master received a copy of Nylyne Piola Paulo's death certificate which shall be filed under seal. She was survived by spouse, Placido Nobrida Esquerra who shall take her share.

On the basis of the foregoing, your Master finds and recommends that this deceased class member's share of the *Kalima* settlement proceeds should be distributed as follows:

**DONDALE HOOVER – ONE-FOURTH (1/4)**  
**PLACIDO NOBRIDA ESQUERRA – ONE-FOURTH (1/4)**  
**HENRIETTA LORENZO – ONE-FOURTH (1/4)**  
**HEIRS OF CATHERINE CHOW – ONE-FOURTH (1/4)**

(R) **KAMAILEOHUALALAI MARY SHOAF**

Your Master previously reported that under the laws of intestacy, Feli Leilani Richardson-Vea, as the surviving spouse of the decedent's surviving spouse, would have the controlling estate. However, your Master also received an email from Ms. Richardson on or about February 7, 2026, requesting that she be removed from this matter.

Since then, Ms. Richardson-Vea contacted your Master and explained that she did not intend to give up her rights to the decedent's settlement funds. She also provided a letter from her medical treater and another email explaining her situation. Attached as Exhibit "4."

Under the Omnibus Order Re: *Kalima* Class Qualified Settlement Trust Proceedings, filed December 29, 2023, Paragraph F provides:

F. Objections to Petitions

Any interested persons or parties who make any objection or otherwise disagree with the Petitions or Master Reports, will be removed from the Probate Plan and referred to the Mediation Center of the Pacific where the parties will have the opportunity to resolve the matter through mediation. When all issues are resolved, the Deceased Class Member's claim will be included back in the

Probate Plan. If the parties are unable to resolve their disputes, they must retain private counsel in order to resolve any disagreements before being included back in the Probate Plan. Any additional expenses incurred in the administration of the Probate Plan resulting from these extra procedures shall be paid from the settlement funds allocated to the Deceased Class Member about whom the parties are in disagreement.

The Probate Plan, approved by the Court in Civ. No. 99-4771-12LWC, provides:

XV. DISPUTED SITUATIONS.

If any Deceased Class Members' heirs or devisees dispute who is entitled to receive settlement funds or in what percentage, they will be referred to mediation. If they are unable to resolve their dispute, they will be advised to retain to private counsel. Distributions from the QST will be made in a manner consistent with the resolution of the dispute, upon order of the Probate Court.

On the basis of the foregoing, your Master amends her prior findings and recommendations and finds and recommends that the Court remove this deceased class member from Petition #26, and advise the parties to contact Mediation Center of the Pacific to attempt to resolve their differences.

Unless and until the parties interested in the Estate of KAMAILEOHUALALAI MARY SHOAF notify the Probate Special Counsel that their disputes have been resolved, this Estate shall not be included in a petition within the Probate Plan.
